Instructions for Presentation (Research Progress Report – Semester III)

Students are required to prepare and deliver a Research Progress Presentation after approval of their dissertation proposal. The objective of this presentation is to demonstrate the progress made in the research work and to ensure that the study is being conducted in accordance with the approved research plan.

The presentation should include a brief overview of the approved proposal, followed by a detailed account of the work completed to date. Students must present preliminary results or findings obtained so far, wherever applicable. Emphasis should be placed on explaining the methodology followed, progress achieved against proposed objectives, and adherence to the approved research design.

Students should identify and discuss any obstacles, limitations, or challenges encountered during the research process and propose modifications or corrective measures, if required. Any changes from the approved proposal must be clearly justified.

The presentation will provide an opportunity to receive guidance and constructive feedback from the supervisor and review committee to ensure that the dissertation is progressing in the right direction before final submission.

A written progress report must be prepared and submitted/uploaded on the GMIU web portal as per prescribed guidelines. This activity ensures continuous monitoring of dissertation work and confirms that the research is proceeding smoothly and according to the planned timeline.
