The Board of Studies (BOS) is a permanent body comprising of 70% members from academia (distinguished Professors) and 30% from industry who are expert in their respective field. The Board of Studies discusses and recommends the Curriculum of all the courses offered by the department from time to time before sending the same to the Academic Council.</p> <p>The Academic Council then considers the proposals from the Board of Studies and makes recommendations to the Governing Body for consideration and approval. The Program then has curricula for the courses approved by the Governing Body.</p> <p>(Please Refer Enclosed Annexure - D)</p>
5.2	What is the Rules/regulations/procedure for revision of the curriculum and when was the curriculum last updated?	<p>The University follows the guidelines of UGC to update and approve the curriculum. A draft of the recommended changes is prepared to be placed for the BOS Meeting, which is held at around the month of May every year</p> <p>In the BOS Meeting, the recommended changes are placed before the external and industry experts as per the UGC Guidelines. Suggestions are received from them and incorporated for further placing for scrutiny and approval in the Academic Council meeting which is normally held in the month of June i.e well before the commencement of the next academic session. The council reviews the same and approves to be placed for the final sanctioning of the curriculum revision by the Governing Body</p> <p>(Please Refer Enclosed Annexure - D)</p>
